APPLICATION FOR ITINERANT PEDDLERS LICENSE

Per Section 4-18 of Lake Station City Code Book

This Application, in triplicate, must be on file with the Clerk-Treasurer no less than fourteen (14) days prior to the issuance of any license. The amount to be paid for a license, under Ord. 70-22, City Code Section 4-18 (1985), shall be \$5.00 per day, \$20.00 per week, \$50.00 per month, and \$150.00 per year. The following information shall be answered in full for issuance of a license to be considered. Attached is a copy of the section from the City of Lake Station Code book with the necessary information needed when completing this form. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

- 8. Two (2) photographs of the applicant taken within sixty (60) days immediately prior to the date of the filing of the application. Pictures shall be 2"x2" showing the head and shoulders of the applicant in a clear and distinguishing manner.
- 9. A full set of fingerprints of the applicant shall be applied to the application under the direction of the Chief of Police or designee thereof.

A statement as to whether or not the applicant has been convicted of any crime, misdemeanor or violation of any municipal ordinance, the nature of the offense and the punishment or penalty assessed therefore. Any itinerant vendors, hawkers, peddlers, solicitors or canvasser shall display the license with a photograph as herein above specified affixed thereto. When requested to do so by any person when offering to sell any goods, wares, or merchandise or to any Police Officer of this City when so requested.

All annual licenses issued under the provisions of this ordinance shall expire on December 31st of the year issued. Other than annual, licenses shall expire on the date specified on the license.

Licenses issued may be revoked by the Common Council after notice and hearing stated in the City Code Book, Section 4-18 section 1.

The time during which itinerant vendors, hawkers, peddlers, solicitors or canvassers may engage in business within the City shall be limited to the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. during the days of Sunday through Saturday, inclusive from October 31st to April 30th inclusive. Hours of 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. Sunday through Saturday inclusive from May 1st to November 1st.

Penalty: Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this sections shall be fined in the sum of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) no more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each violation thereafter. Each separate act of attempted or accomplished vending, hawking, peddling, soliciting, or canvassing without a license shall constitute a separate offense.

No license shall be issued for less than one (1) day, nor for longer than one (1) year.
